

# Massive Scar Across the Hill



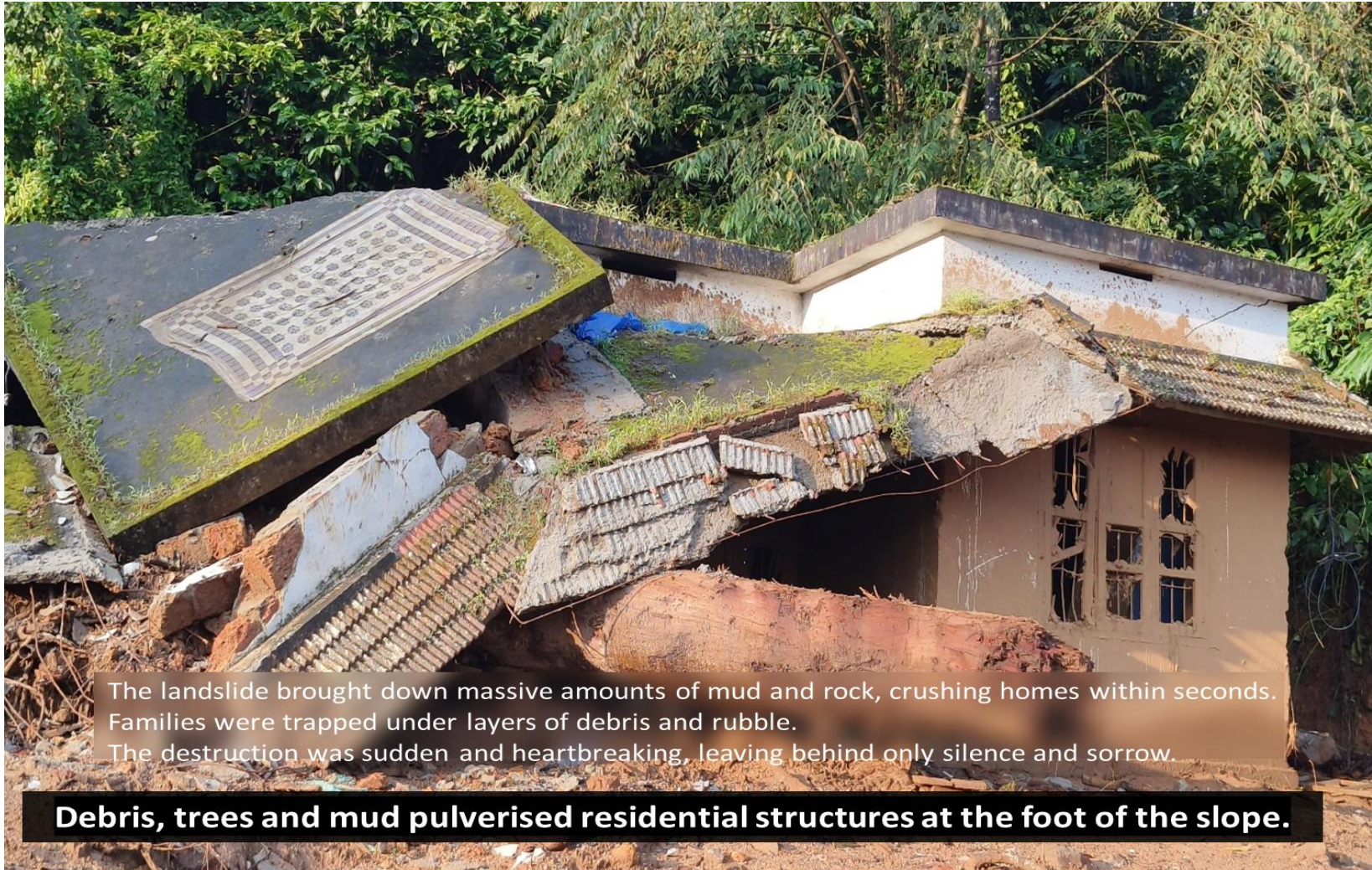
